

PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION (LEGAL NOTICE)

1. Personal Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The Controller of the processing of your personal data is Olympic Broadcasting Services, S.L. (OBS), with trade register no. B83747691 and registered address in Calle Torrelaguna 75, 28027 Madrid.

OBS has appointed a Data Protection Officer for both OBS and Olympic Channel Services, S.L. (“OCS”). His/her contact details are as follow:

2. Personal data processing purposes

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of managing any requests or enquiries you send through mediarequests@obs.tv.

Your data may also be processed in the context of any specific job opportunities you apply for or when you submit your CV through careers@obs.es as a general application not related to a particular job opening.

3. Personal data processing - legal basis

Data processing for the management of any requests or enquiries submitted through the e-mail address stated above is legitimate under the consent you give to OBS by drafting and submitting such e-mail.

With regard to data processing related to the reception of your CV when applying for a specific job opportunity, or when the CV is sent even without a connection to a specific job opportunity, through the abovementioned e-mail, the legal basis will be the performance of the corresponding contract (which includes also the only potential performance of a future contract).

4. Personal data storage limitation (retention period)

With regard to your requests or enquiries, your personal data can be stored for as long as it is necessary to satisfy your enquiry or request.

In relation to the application for any job positions or the sending of your CV even without connection to a specific job opportunity, your CV will be stored for the duration of the specific selection process or, in case you are selected, for as long as you are employed by OBS/OCS. Once your data is no longer needed for these purposes, it will be blocked during the period were such data may be necessary for the exercise or the defence against administrative or legal claims, i.e. for a maximum period of 3 (three) years, and may only be unblocked and processed again exclusively for such purpose. Once this period is over, your personal data will be definitely erased.

5. Personal data recipients

Your personal data may be disclosed to Public Administrations, Authorities and Entities, including Courts and Tribunals, if required by the applicable legislation at any given moment.

Service providers already contracted by OBS/OCS, and those that may be contracted in the future, may have access to your personal data when acting as data processors.

6. Security measures

OBS has implemented the appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent the alteration, loss, misuse, unauthorized processing and access, or theft of your personal data, taking into consideration the available technology.

7. Data subject rights

You may exercise your rights of access to, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection to processing and portability of your personal data at any given moment, and to the extent established by the applicable legislation.

You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any given moment.

You may exercise your rights through a written submission (subject GDPR, Rights) to Calle Torrelaguna 75, 28027 Madrid, or through an e-mail to derechos@obs.tv. In order to do so, you must prove your identity by submitting a copy of your national identification or corresponding documentation.

In any case, we inform you of your right to lodge a complaint before Spain's supervisory authority: *Agencia Española de Protección de Datos*.
